#### Mayor's Message

Orland Park Business Community,

Thank you to those who were able to join us at the recent State of the Village event hosted by the Orland Park Area Chamber of Commerce and the Village of Orland Park. It is great to see so many of Orland Park's business leaders so actively involved in the community as a whole.

At the State of the Village, I addressed issues regarding Public Safety, Finances, Infrastructure Improvement and Economic Development.

The Orland Park Police Department continues to provide phenomenal public safety services to the community. Index crimes have been declining for the past four years. In 2011, there were 1690 index crimes in Orland Park; in 2020 we had 691. These numbers include major crimes such as homicide and rape but also include retail theft, which is what drives this number up with our vast retail makeup in the Village. Property crime is down from over 1,300 occurrences in 2016 to just over 660 in 2020.

In 2020, our traffic enforcement officers issued 2,788 speeding citations with 82 cited with aggravated speeding (greater than 26 miles over the speed limit). The message we are giving those with a need for speed is to slow down when driving in, around and through Orland Park. Vehicle accidents increased by 4% when compared to 2019. 159th Street and LaGrange Road had the most accidents in 2020 with 37 occurring at that intersection.

Criminals are not getting away with crimes in Orland Park. Our Police Department is apprehending those who choose to break the law in Orland Park. The problem is Cook County's court system "catch and release" mentality where those who commit crime are given minimal fines and let right back out on the street where many become repeat offenders.

Orland Park remains the safest city in the region for towns over 55,000 in population. We intend to continue on this path well into the future.

While COVID-19 had a huge financial impact on many, we have weathered the storms and are persevering nonetheless. The Village has not skipped a beat when it comes to providing services while collecting only 6.47% of your total tax bill. 79% of your tax bill can be attributed to taxes collected by schools and the fire district.

Since 2016, we have reduced our long-term debt by \$50 million while not reducing services offered. We were able to handle the reduction in revenue due to our strong financial position and smart planning.

In 2021, you will see the renovation of 16 parks, including 39 basketball, tennis and volleyball courts. This is a great improvement from years prior when we saw 1-2 parks per year improved upon or updated.

We were glad to be in a position to offer several economic incentives and programs to assist Orland Park's businesses as many struggled to make ends meet during the state-mandated shut down. These included our Shop, Dine, Play program, sales tax sharing, manufacturing incentives, outdoor dining arrangements as well as our newest app, Orland Perks.

Orland Park continues to be the destination of choice for many "new to Orland Park" businesses. We welcomed many new businesses in 2020 and the first part of 2021 and will soon welcome Angelo Caputo's Fresh Market, Rei, Pete's Fresh Market, Moran Family of Brands, X Golf, BJ's Brew House and Raising Cane's to name a few.

Last, but certainly not least, the Village is excited about finally moving forward with the development of the Orland Park Triangle area with Orland Park's Edwards Realty. This site needs to benefit ALL of Orland Park and will be designed with that in mind.

#### **Local Teens Gain Green Thumbs During Gardening Week**

The Bridge Teen Center Hosts Week of Free Programming Promoting the Benefits of Gardening

The Bridge Teen Center celebrated the arrival of Spring by hosting "Gardening Week" for its 7th-12th grade students during the week of May 17. Led by the organization's Founder and Executive Director, Priscilla Steinmetz, this week focused on engaging and educating students about holistic gardening practices. The week finished off with students working together to plant veggies, herbs, and flowers in The Bridge Teen Center's outdoor garden, which they will be able to care for as they return to The Bridge throughout the summer.

"We hope that those students who attended our "Gardening Week" programs discover a new passion and interest in gardening - maybe even bringing some of what they learned home to share with parents and siblings," continued Steinmetz.

All Bridge Teen Center programs and events are FREE and open to teens currently in 7th-12th grade with an approved student membership application on file. Students who are graduating 6th grade this year and entering 7th grade in the Fall will be eligible for membership this coming Summer. ### Sandburg High School Named A Top Illinois High School: U.S. News
