Mayor's Message

With summertime in full swing in Orland Park, it is great to see so many people continuing to choose Orland Park as their destination for shopping, dining and enjoying our vast outdoor spaces. Despite the harsh restrictions imposed by the state during the pandemic, Orland Park's business community has remained steadfast and has weathered the storm. I encourage you to visit the Village's new Economic Development website at <u>buildop.org</u> to stay on top of any newly available spaces, business incentives and more.

Orland Park has launched a Business Retention & Expansion (BRE) Program to proactively connect with existing businesses to better understand and respond to their needs. If you are an existing business owner or operator in the community, we want to hear from you. The Village has created a short online survey, <u>https://buildop.org/business-retention-expansion/</u>, that will gather broad information on your business to help us learn more about your existing challenges and opportunities. Once you've completed the survey, Village representatives will work with you to find time for a follow-up conversation to learn more about how the Village of Orland Park can be a better partner to your business and the entire business community.

The relationship between the Village of Orland Park and the businesses that call Orland Park home is an important partnership. Together, we work towards what is best for the community as a whole while keeping the economic health of Orland Park strong. This is something that has been built over many years and remains an admirable trait of our Village. Recently, steps were taken to strengthen this partnership.

An ordinance was approved at the July 19 board meeting that requires those holding business licenses in Orland Park to cooperate fully with the Orland Park Police Department in suppressing illegal, disorderly and/or violent conduct. Police have been called for service due to criminal acts occurring at local establishments and, in some instances, the businesses then refuse to sign the criminal complaint. The problem with this is that once the criminals know that said business will not sign a complaint and they will not be held accountable, that location becomes a regular spot for that type of criminal activity.

This is not safe for the police officers responding, for community members who may be caught in the middle of the incident, for other businesses that may be targeted, or for those on the roads as the suspects flee recklessly though our neighborhoods. As partners in the community, we must work together for what is best for Orland Park. Public safety remains paramount in Orland Park. Thank you for your continued efforts and partnership in maintaining this standard.
